**Owen County Lower Elementary, Owen County Upper Elementary and Maurice Bowling Middle School** will continue their participation in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Option. This year **Owen County High School** also qualified and will be participating in the CEP option. This will allow all students enrolled in Owen County Schools access to breakfast and lunch at no charge for the entire 2017-2018 school year.

The Owen County School Nutrition department's main goal is to feed students healthy meals so that they are ready to learn. By providing breakfast and lunch free to all students, the department can feed more children, benefiting our school, our students, and our community.
