



Good News about Kentucky Public Schools!

- 678,000 amazing kids enrolled in KY public schools
- Approximately 100,000 dedicated employees serving in public education
- 867 dedicated Board of Education members across the commonwealth
- Over 5,600 parents serving on SBDM councils
- Over 2.9 MILLION volunteer logged hours in KY schools last year
- Kentucky ranked 8th in student performance improvement in last 2 decades by Harvard Study
- 2015 Building a Grad Nation Report Called KY a “Beacon for ALL OTHER STATES” for eliminating opportunity gap between low income and all other students for graduation on time
- 2017 KY ranked 17th in US NEWS and World Report on best rankings of high schools by state
- Quality Counts 2016: 4th/8th grade proficiency rank 24th in Nation, sixth highest national growth factor (6%)
- KY graduation rate 89.7% compared to 84% nationally
- 92.5% of KY students successfully transition to college or career
- Over 32,000 students taking over 51,000 AP exams in KY last year
- 25,600 students scored a qualifying score of 3, 4, or 5 (50%) on AP exams
- Only 17 states give ACT to 100% of juniors - KY ranks 8th in performance
