



## SCHOOL FOOD PANTRY

Owen County Schools and the Youth Services Center, in conjunction with the Free Store Food Bank School Pantry, offers a School Food Pantry. The School Food Pantry was developed to provide nutritious, healthy food to children and their families for preparation and consumption at their place of residence. Participation requirements include that at least one student living in the household must be enrolled in either the Maurice Bowling Middle School or the Owen County High School, however, food will be provided for everyone living in the household. This program **DOES NOT** replace the Power Pack program.

Families will be able to select the food items preferred by your family. Food items may vary from month to month.

Parents/Guardians must call Kim Duvall at 502-484-4016 to schedule an appointment for the food pickup. The food pickup is scheduled twice a month. The pickup location is in the Youth Services Center, Room 131 at the Owen County High School. IF SCHOOL IS CANCELLED, THE PANTRY WILL ALSO BE CLOSED, an alternate date will be provided.
