

Owen County Elementary NTI Day Plan

Students will have a WHITE folder in their backpack with the Non-Traditional Instruction (NTI) assignments. On the first day that an NTI day is called for weather, students will complete Day 1 of the NTI work. In the event a second NTI day is called, students will complete Day 2's assignment. NTI days do not have to be made up at the end of the year. It is considered a school day, therefore it is required that your child completes the school work. There will be directions as to the assignments your child will need to complete each NTI day. Your child should bring the completed NTI work in the white folder on the next day we return to the school building.

Your child's teacher will be available to answer any questions about NTI assignments from 9-12 and 3-6 on NTI days. You can also request to set up a Google Meet in order for the teacher to help with any assignments. Teachers will be calling and messaging families to check in and see if assistance is needed.

Each grade level has listed assignments for at least 5 days of NTI work. The assignments will be updated as needed. The teachers have explained the NTI work to your child, but if you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to your child's teacher.
